Key Responsibilities:

The Heriot's Super6 Team Manager is a voluntary role and is responsible for ensuring all Heriot's Rugby Super6 team operations and off field logistics are professionally prepared and delivered.

- Coordination of off pitch player needs and working with the Super6 coaching team to devise and deliver rugby itineraries for training and match days
- Maintaining up to date player records for the full Super6 playing squad including player registration and team sheet submissions via Scottish Rugby's Management System (SCRUMS)
- Assist in the ordering and allocation of kit for the entire Super6 squad
- Lead in terms of the values and behaviours expected of the playing group
- Coordination of player appearances, sponsor interactions, social media coordination and junior section liaison

On match days the team manager's role is vital to the team's success and responsibilities include;

- Assisting with changing room set-up
- Coordination of match day equipment
- Pitch side coordination of substitutions/injury management
- Liaising with citing commissioner for any disciplinary matters that arise
